

# **Vehicle Suitability Guidelines**

All vehicles used in P1 assessments must be safe, registered and meet the vehicle suitability requirements.

A checklist is included in the vehicle suitability guidelines.

A car used in an assessment, other than a driving school vehicle with dual controls and a current roadworthy certificate, must have.

- A WORKING handbrake that is located between the front seats in a position where it can be easily be applied by the driving assessor.
- Car is reasonably clean and tidy.
- A clean windscreen that is not cracked or obscured within the arc of the wipers or compromises its integrity.
- The speedometer must be visible from the passenger seat to monitor speed.
- Working Brake and Indicator lights with no white light showing, including side indicators and Reverse lights.
- Side and rearview mirrors are to be in good condition.
- Working windscreen wipers and demisters.
- The following dash warning lights are not accepted.
  - Break warning
  - Stability control
  - ABS
  - SRS Airbag
  - Low fuel light
- Minimum tyre tread depth of 1.5mm over the entire tread width of the tyre not flat or damaged in any way.
